## Parks & Recreation

Park Projects this fiscal year 2012/2013 are: raise the backstop 6 feet on the left ballfield- there has been a bid accepted from Maybury Fencing for \$2650.00. Construct new picnic shelter new trail area- this is under construction, purchase new picnic tables, new retainage wall around persimmon grove (parking lot) - the block is on hand/in house, new retainage wall along road beside ballpark- block is on hand/in house, relocate parking posts in parking lot- in house, plant new grass/plants and trees this spring- in house, trail signs and markings- in house, refurbishing old playground equipment- in house, if funds permitting begin second picnic shelter next to new playground.

# Water & Sewer

There was discussion about the problems we are having with grinder pumps, some of them are being misused by the homeowners.

Jerry Williams made a motion to adopted a resolution of the town council of the Town of Stanfield North Carolina adopting a policy that is applicable to all sewer customers served by the Town of Stanfield, all were in favor, motion carried. (See attached)

A grinder pump information sheet, a letter and a copy of the adopted resolution will be sent to each homeowner that has a grinder pump. We want to make sure the homeowners are aware of the resolution and the guidelines.

The sewer and water department are in the process of marking a map where valves, etc are located.

Willow Street lift station needs some repairs.

The pump station on Hwy 200 needs a gasket to be replaced, and the flow meter is reading wrong, and there is a technician coming on Friday to recalibrate it. There is a manhole cover to be replaced.

Some of the drainage problems around town (around the school and S Love Chapel) have been fixed.

# Planning and Zoning

There is a 40 acre tract behind the Family Sports & Fitness center the new landowner has come to the town asking it to be rezoned. There will be a planning and zoning meeting January 28, 2013 to discuss this matter, then it will be brought back to the commissioners for recommendation. The new land owner would like to put a home and dog kennel and grooming area. Everything he is asking to do does go along with the zoning guidelines. We will put up rezoning signs after the zoning meeting.

# **Town Administrator**

The CVB will change some of it by-laws so that there could be an alternate on the board. We could have an alternate if the board chooses to. The board is content without an alternate.
