Minutes of Regular Meeting for August  
on August 4, 2022**

**Determination of Quorum**

However, the Town of Stanfield is prepared to fully fund the School Resource Officer position at Stanfield Elementary School regardless of a grant award for the 22-23 school year. All were in favor.
